BSRA RELEASE 1 - A - 50. January 1950. --- Reprinted by request, 5-15-50.

We present herewith quotation and summary of an article published in the WYANDOTTE ECHO, of Kansas City, Kansas, January 6, 1950. A copy of the ECHO was sent the BSRA Director by Associate DONALD J. YORK, 1808 Jefferson, Kansas City, Mo.

Nearly all of the facts alleged in this article, concerning the Disc and its occupants, are in substantial agreement with facts already published by us with regard to the Disc which fell in Mexico. Also, Mr. Coulter's (probable) guess concerning the origin of the Disc on Venus, comes close to the strong affirmations from "occult" sources that it came from Venus-Etheria.

Between Jan. 6 and the date of this reprint, May 15, this story has un dergone the usual vicissitudes, which are somewhat after this pattern. Some remarkable facts are reported by apparently responsible people, often by persons of excellent business or professional standing. After being "interviewed" by various "authorities", derided by newspapers, and harassed by fanatics and sensation-mongers, they find it best to explain that they were misquoted in the first place, or "merely joking", or repeating some unfounded rumour. Sometimes, however, such "retractions" are themselves retracted later; more frequently still, the small well of information goes suddenly dry, and the person concerned refuses to say anything further either pro or contra. And we are informed that in the armed services at least, there is explicit and official censorship on reports of strange flying objects, and this attitude is reflected by the major news services (press and radio). We mention these facts, that our Associates may keep in mind the difficulties of obtaining "evidence" that will remain unshaken, or any "proof" that will not be rejected by the properly "conditioned" sceptic.

Under such circumstances, the best we can say about the following item is already stated in the first sentence of paragraph 2 above. The present writer believes that the data are substantially correct and in conformity with many other factual items which our Associates are continually sending to BSRA Hdqrs.

The ECHO derives its information from Mr. Rudy Fick, a "well-known Kansas City auto dealer. Mr. Fick was in conversation with with the manager of the Ford Agency in Denver, when two engineers arrived. One of these, a man named Coulter, said that he "crashed the gate" at a radar station near the N.M.-Arizona border, and there saw two of the "saucers", one badly damaged, the other almost intact. They consisted of a cockpit about six feet in diameter, and a ring about 8 ft. across and 2 ft. thick surrounding the cabin. In flight the was believed to revolve at high speed while the cabin remained stationary. The craft has a bearing type tripod landing gear. The cabin was constructed of a metal resembling Aluminum but the actual make-up of the metal defied analysis.

Each of the ships had been occupied by a crew of two, and in one of them the bodies were not disfigured. They were identical with those of earth people except that they were about 3 ft. in height. They were blonde and beardless and their teeth were without filling or cavities. Their clothing was a blue material unknown on earth and the threads seemed to be a kind of wire. The shoes were a slip-on type. The jackets had six buttons and the trousers were tight fitting. They were no under-garments but had their bodies taped.

In each ship there was food in tablet form, one type about half the size of Alka-Selzer tablets; another was a small brown cube which swelled to a volume of about a gallon when placed in water. Water contained in the ships weighed

twice as much as water known to us.

The ships seemed to be magnetically controlled and powered, as there was no power plant in the ship itself. There was no armament or exploratory equip ment. It was surmised that radar waves caused them to crash. There was a clock device adjusted to the lunar month, 28 days.

Mr. Coulter is reported to have said, that according to his information a / of similar craft had been found in the U.S. during the last two years, and that these were in possession of the Government. Mr Fick believed that the Government desires the information to spread slowly from unofficial sources, to avoid effects of a surprise announcement that inter-planetery travel is possible.

For those interested in the psychic side of the BSR investigations, we may add that the M.P. Controls remarked that the 'wire clothing' was designed to insulate the wearers from magnetic conditions and effects, and that the bodies were taped toavoid the effects of air pressure. The statement that the metal 'defied analysis' fits well enough with the attempted analysis made at the University of Chicago (printed in RR), and with reports concerning the Disc said to have landed in Chihuahua. Incidentally, the reports concerning this last named landing came to us from a prominent and respensible business man, who was wellacquainted with at least one of the scientists who made an on-the-spot investigation, and who passed on the facts to our informant... Returning briefly to the Controls - they have asserted repeatedly, ever since the fall of 1946,, that all of the strange sky craft are etheric in origin, and that the disc-shaped craft come from the etheric regions of Venus - not the visible planet. They have also asserted that our radar beam is felt by them, but has no strong effect; that we have no defense against them if they wished to attack; that we should take great care not to antagonize them - and that some of them have sufficient power and scientific knowledge to destroy our earth by demagnetizing it - but would never attempt this, or be permitted to attempt it by the higher governing entities of our solar system. And according to the Controls, again, it is of utmost and imperative importance, that we make every effort to enter into friendly communica tion with the Etherian visitors - preferably by means of colored lights forming symbolic designs.

Your BSR Directors deeply concur in this. There is here a great racial opportunity, since the knowledge and helpfulness of these Etheric people might advance our science by centuries at a single stroke, as well as solving a multitude of our social and economic problems and making an end to warfare. There should be a hundred groups throughout the country earnestly engaged in this project — since it is almost certain that NO governmental authority, and NO group of scientists (with reputations to lose) will make any systematic attempt at carrying through this greatest of all human enterprises, which might well inaugurate a new era in the history of humanity. (I do not dare leave these words unwritten, but I write them almost without hope!)

A word about contemporary radio stupidities. The broadcaster Henry J. Taylor is making a last valiant effort (probably under instructions) to convince the public that the whole host of incfedible etheric phenomena are "secret weapons" of our glorious republic. The total of his remarks (sent out in print by General Motors) is so riddled with contradictions, half-truths and mental fumblings, that it is not worth the destructive analysis it invites. The commentator Walter ("Windy") Winchell contradicts himself repeatedly, then asserts that he has been consistent, all-revealing, in effect a chosen intimate of the Gods. But by such men is the public mind conditioned to that which it wishes to believe.

GENERAL SPOTS AGAIN - - and, HOW BSRA MEMBERS CAN HELP:

If you're bored by talk about ether ships and flying discs, I'm sorry - but they won't go away simply because you shut your eyes. The only phenomenon we know of which is even more remarkable is the kind of mentality displayed by the following quote from Newsweek, which is quoting General Carl Spaatz (again) - also known as spots-before-the-eyes Spaatz: towit -

"If the American people are capable of getting so excited over something that doesn't exist, God help us if anyone ever plasters us with a real atomic bomb."

To be blunt and almost nawsty about it, there are very few alternatives in explaining the Spaatzes of this world. Either (1) Spots is grossly ignorant of the data, has no idea of its extent and validity, (2) or he is a mental incompetent, plain or fancy psycho'of some sort (3) or he is being stupid-by-order and jackass-by-duress - which is the most probable and charitable of the three guesses. Other Spotses blossom out daily but our three alternatives cover most of them.

We add that clips continue to come in by the scores, to the BSR Hdqrs., from all parts of the U.S. and Canada, and not a few from Hawaii, the Philippines, the China Coast, Africa, and Southern Europe. We have given up trying to make individual acknowledgment, but we read them all carefully, thank all our helpers, and hope they will continue to send them.

We now have a two-page letter addressed to "Fellow Citizens and Governmental Authorities" covering the gist of the situation (re the Etheric Visitation), which has had satisfactory repercussions in some quarters (newspaper editorials, chiefly). If any of you can place a few of these where they are likely to be read, and will let us know, we'll forward a few copies.

Try colored lights, on-and-off, showing symbols (occult, old Masonic, clasped hands, the value of PI, 3.1416 etc. also constant repetition of radio and radar signals probably using numerical values; PI would be understood by any civilized persons). The main idea is to show <u>friendly intent</u>. Get the lights out on flat ground away from all other ground lights. BLUE probably the best color - but work out your own methods - and the sooner the better, for all of us.

"Little Toughies" again - or a faire tale anyway.

This is from Rollin Palmer's column, "Buffalo's Band - wagon", in the Buffalo Courier Express of 5-4-50, and the clip comes from BSR Associate Edw. S. Schultz. Mr. Palmer's informant, in turn, is one Bill Nelson, 326

Bryant St., student of Spanish at the Berlitz School, who wrote out a translation of a "flying disc story to top all flying disc stories", published by <u>La Hora</u>, "a responsible newspaper published in Quito, Ecuador. We quote Mr. Palmer:

.....Almost incredible, the account tells of a fighting two-foot-tall figure driving the disc - a figure encased in clothes of armor or metallic cloth (1). Nelson sent along the clipping with his translation.

La Hora claims that a small flying disc crashed on the Laredo, Texas, airport, April 16, mortally injuring its diminutive pilot. The story asserted taht Federal authorities at Laredo prevented general publication of the crash (2).

A director of civil aviation at Laredo is quoted as saying: "For several days the discs have been seen on both sides of the Rio Bravo (3). Before crashing the disc deliberately buzzed the field at several thousand miles an hour (4). Then it circled the field six or seven times, each time more slowly, finally diving into the field, to narrowly miss the largest hangar.

"Following the crash, airport personnel and firemen are reported to have hurried to the scene. From the crushed disc, measuring only a couple of yards across, they pulled the pilot, a figure not more than two feet tall...

"Local firemen administered oxygen and the tiny man revived suddenly and started fighting. Leaping tohis feet, the paper reports, the tiny figure jumped upward and struck Nat'l Guard Sgt. Joe Jena in the face, felling him. As the others drew back the tiny man gasped for breath and fell unconscious, apparently unable to breathe our air.

"Oxygen was again administered and the visitor again came to fighting, and displaying a strength that made it impossible for the guardsmen and firemen to hold him. Within seconds he again lapsed into unconsciousness. Three more times they revived him only to have him fight free of the mask and restraining hands and pass out. Further attempts to revive him were without avail."

One of the police officials was quoted as saying that several men were momentarily stunned by some sort of ray pistol at their first approach to the craft and it was taken from him when they pulled him from the wreck. It was reported that the little man weighed about 300 pounds (5) despite his small size and was wearing a helmet equipped with an antenna. The disc, made of an unidentified metal (6) was apparethly a one-man flyer. The interior of the control cockpit housed only a few pieces of equipment, the paper said, probably "their" equivalent of radio and radar. A series of jet openings, possibly rockets, rimmed the thin edge of the craft. La Hora did not reproduce a photograph but reported a U.S. paper has a very clear picture (7) and added that the story was either of paramount importance or a gigantic hoax perpetrated by other newspapers. La Hora stated that the body and the disc were gathered up under the direction of the FBI and flown to Washington.

Item (1), the small size of the occupant, item (6), the lack of equipment have been reported in other real or alleged falls. Item (4) jibes with many reports. (5) the weight or density of the body is consistent with the etheric origin. Item (3) agrees with many reports. Item (7) - you'll never see this picture. The prompt action of authorities to cover up such data has become familiar - so, we have to read Ecuador newspapers to get news from Texas!!! We think, the "gigantic hoax" theory is harder to believe than the alleged facts themselves.

Based on a compilation made by the Albert & Mary Lasker Foundation, New York City; figures are for 1948, the latest year available. Printed in the Electronic Medical Digest, Spring 1950.
