

Flying Discs Still Studied, Says Spaatz

BOISE, Idaho, Dec. 18 (UP)—General Carl A. Spaatz, Chief of the U. S. Air Force, revealed to a Boise newspaper today that military authorities are still investigating the flying discs reported over the U. S. this year.

The general reported the continuing investigation in a letter answering several questions submitted by the Boise Statesman. Spaatz said he's not convinced that discs were or are flying over the United States, but it "would be unfair to discard the possibility" that the discs are the result of foreign experimentation.

Spaatz was asked:

Are you convinced that such objects were flying above the United States?

"No."

Is it possible that discs are foreign experimentation?

"Nothing concrete has been established to answer this question in the affirmative but in the absence of logical explanation, it would be unfair to discard the possibility."

Do you want people observing the objects to report them to the Army?

"Yes."

Have you investigated any disc reports in the last two months?

"Yes."
